

AN ACT

To further amend Sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 1-90, as amended by Public Law No. 1-121, to reapportion certain funds to defray the administrative costs of the Kosrae State Commission on Improvement Projects; to change the composition of such Commission; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 1-90, as amended by Public
2 Law No. 1-121, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$325,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
5 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of
6 funding the following public projects in the State of Kosrae:

- 7 (1) School buses \$ 90,000
- 8 (2) Road construction and related costs. 50,000
- 9 (3) Sea/River Wall 15,000
- 10 (4) Farm road (Inek) 30,000
- 11 (5) Channel (Inyoa) 10,000
- 12 (6) Recreation facilities (Kufwen Me
13 Srital). 10,000
- 14 (7) Financial assistance to residents of
15 Kosrae and citizens of the Federated States of
16 Micronesia to attend law school. 10,000
- 17 (8) Heavy Equipment 100,000
- 18 (9) Municipal communications 5,000
- 19 (10) Administrative costs of Kosrae State
20 Commission on Improvement Projects 5,000

21 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 1-90, as amended by Public
22 Law No. 1-121, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

1 "Section 2. There is hereby created a Kosrae State Commis-
2 sion on Improvement Projects. The Commission shall be
3 composed of the following: the Chief Magistrate from each
4 of the municipalities of Lelu, Tafunsak, Malem and Utwa; the
5 Kosrae State Director of Public Works, and the Kosrae State
6 Director of Resources and Development; and one appointee each
7 from the Kosrae Delegation to the Congress of the Federated
8 States of Micronesia and from the Speaker of the State
9 Legislature.

10 The Commission should meet to organize itself and to
11 select a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman no later than May 1,
12 1980. A quorum of the Commission is five members; PROVIDED,
13 however, that each Chief Magistrate or his appointee repre-
14 senting each Municipality is present at each meeting. The
15 Commission shall have the authority to:

16 (1) Obligate funds appropriated and allotted to the
17 Commission by the Congress for projects in Kosrae;

18 (2) Award and enter into contracts for projects; giving
19 prior consideration to bids by Kosraean individuals or corpo-
20 rations qualified and capable of performing fully and without
21 delay of such projects;

22 (3) Assess damage to private property caused by projects
23 and negotiate written settlements on amounts of compensation,
24 such written settlements to be treated as obligations for
25 purposes of the Financial Management Act of 1979;

1 (4) Establish priorities for the performance of
2 projects, but ensuring that each municipality is treated as
3 equally as possible;


4 (5) Submit all reports required by applicable law, to
5 include, but not limited to the Financial Management Act of
6 1979;

7 (6) Reallot no more than 10% of the funds apportioned
8 by any subsection of a law appropriating a sum to the
9 Commission; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the amount apportioned by
10 any subsection shall not be increased by more than 20% by
11 means of reallotment between subsections."

12 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia, or upon its becoming
14 law without such approval.
