**PRESIDENTIAL COMM. NO. 4-104**  
**FSM CONGRESS**

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$500,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1986, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be  
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
4 1986, for the purpose of funding public projects in the State of Yap.

5           Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act shall  
6 be apportioned as follows:

- 7           (1) Outer islands agriculture programs ..... \$ 30,000
- 8           (2) Medical referral and supplies ..... 50,000
- 9           (3) Warehouse for Yap Memorial Hospital ..... 60,000
- 10          (4) Public Transportation System ..... 50,000
- 11          (5) Road improvement ..... 60,000
- 12          (6) Student center, Outer Islands High School .... 40,000
- 13          (7) Ngulu Community Center ..... 20,000
- 14          (8) Fais Community Center ..... 25,000
- 15          (9) Gapchar (Gagil) Community Center ..... 20,000
- 16          (10) Supplemental renovation, Rull Municipal  
17 Office ..... 30,000
- 18          (11) Satawal Community Center ..... 35,000
- 19          (12) Madrich Village ..... 35,000
- 20          (13) Repair and renovation, Weloy Municipal  
21 Office ..... 10,000
- 22          (14) Repair and renovation, Yap Congressional

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1	Delegation Office .....	\$ 25,000
2	(15) Outer islands youth programs .....	5,000
3	(16) Yap Islands proper youth programs .....	5,000

4       Section 3. The Governor of Yap State may reprogram up to 15  
5 percent to and from the funds apportioned under subsections (1), (2),  
6 (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), (13), (15), and  
7 (16) of section 2 of this act.

8       Section 4. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
9 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable  
10 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of  
11 1979. The allottee for the funds apportioned under subsections (1),  
12 (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), (13), (15),  
13 and (16) of section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State.  
14 The allottee for the funds apportioned under subsection (14) of section  
15 2 of this act shall be the chairman of the Yap congressional delegation.  
16 The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or  
17 so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes  
18 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
19 of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate  
20 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1986.

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1 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
3 law without such approval.
