FOURTH SPECIAL SESSION, 1987

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 4-384, C.D.1, C.D.2

AN ACT

To further amend title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-82, by repealing sections 601 to 603 of chapter 6 and adding new sections 601 to 603 in lieu thereof for the purpose of designating National holidays and setting forth certain conditions for their observance, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-82, is hereby further
3 amended by repealing section 601 of chapter 6 in its entirety
4 and adding a new section 601 of chapter 6 to read as follows:

5 "Section 601. National holidays. The following days shall
6 be observed as National holidays throughout the Federated
7 States of Micronesia:

8 (1) The first day of January of each year, which is
9 hereby designated as New Year's Day;

10 (2) The tenth day of May of each year, which is hereby
11 designated as Federated States of Micronesia Day to
12 commemorate the effective date of the Constitution of the
13 Federated States of Micronesia;

14 (3) The third day of November of each year, which is
15 hereby designated as Independence Day to commemorate the
16 termination of the United Nations Trusteeship Agreement as
17 it applied to the Federated States of Micronesia and the
18 commencement of full self-government for the people of the
19 Federated States of Micronesia; and

20 (4) The twenty-fifth day of December of each year,
21 which is hereby designated as Christmas Day."

22 Section 2. Title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-82, is hereby further
2 amended by repealing section 602 of chapter 6 in its entirety and
3 adding a new section 602 of chapter 6 to read as follows:

4 "Section 602. Conditions of observance. All holidays set
5 forth in section 601 of this chapter shall, if they occur
6 on a Saturday, be observed on the preceding Friday, and
7 shall, if they occur on a Sunday, be observed on the
8 following Monday."


9 Section 3. Title 1 of the Code of the Federated States of
10 Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 4-82, is hereby further
11 amended by repealing section 603 of chapter 6 in its entirety and
12 adding a new section 603 of chapter 6 to read as follows:

13 "Section 603. Other holidays. No holidays other than
14 those set forth in section 601 of this chapter shall be
15 observed by any employee or official of the National
16 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia."

17 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
18 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
19 law without such approval.
